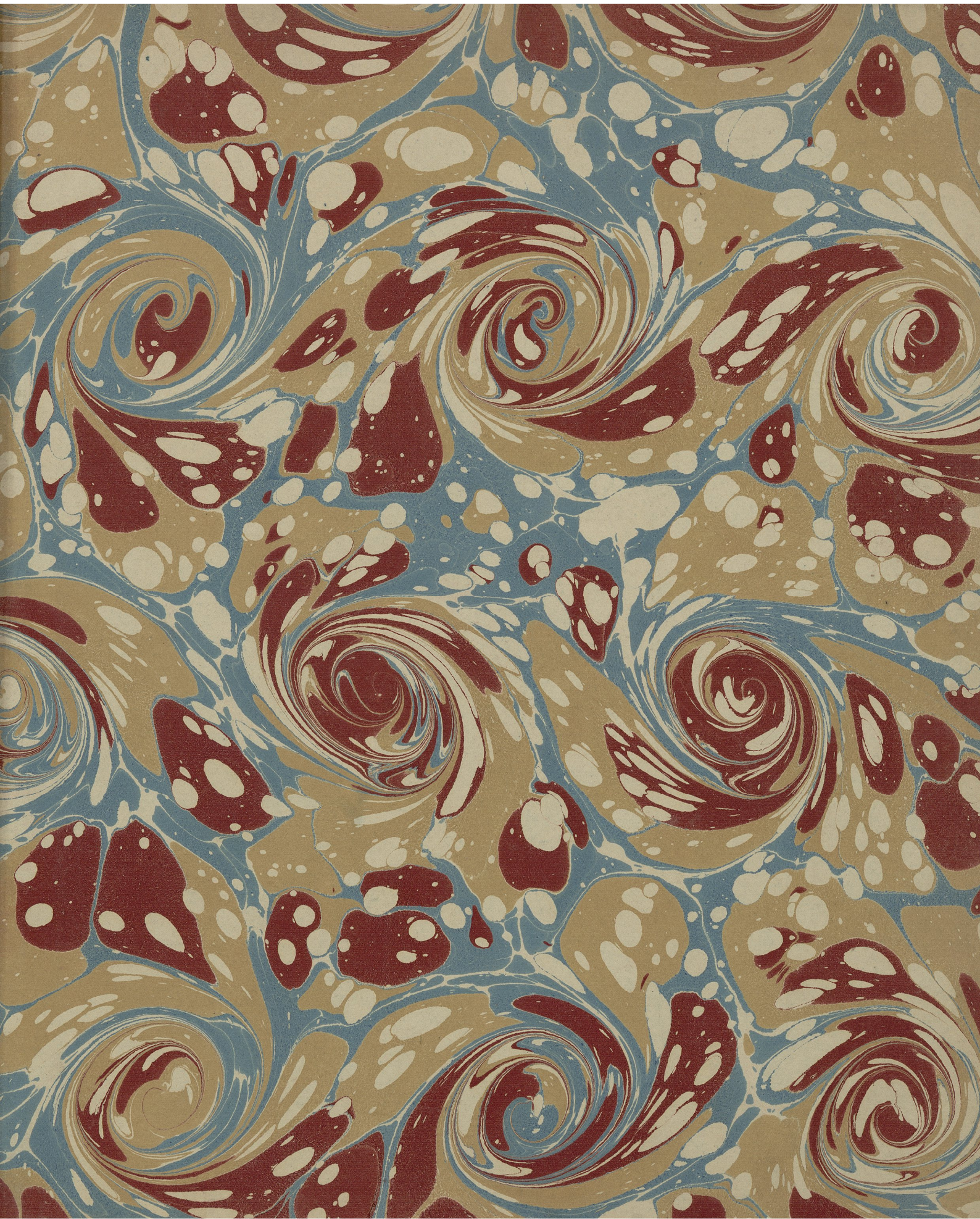

Mr. Nezer has been chiefly desirous to present to scholars an accurate edition of the Text - This he has laboured with the most assiduous care - and I hope that he has succeeded in the object of his ambition in such a manner as will obtain your approbation as well as that of every other Competent judge -

The Author has also added Philological & Geographical notes in Greek with the view of explaining the difficulties which present themselves to young Students -

I should feel much gratified if you w^d favour me (when you have had an opportunity to examine it) with your opinion as to its suitability for the use of Students in the Gymnasia & Universities in general - and I sh^d also be glad to see a Critical Notice of it in some of the Parisian
